## **Small Group Questions**

### **Series: Holiness is a Verb**

1. Some people feel more comfortable with the rules (law), while others feel more comfortable without rules (grace). Which side do you lean toward?

2. Read the Ten Commandments (Exodus 20). Which of these commandments makes you feel the most uncomfortable?

Which has the most "baggage" for you? Which is hardest for you to love?

3. Our passage cites the 10th commandment "You shall not covet". Coveting, it seems, is related to the "American Dream" of materialism, prosperity and comfort. In our community, many people struggle with these things. How are you doing in this area?

4. Our passage says the Law is "holy, righteous and good". What would change in your life if you personally embraced this truth?

5. Do you worry that we might become legalistic if we treat the Law like this passage tells us to.

6. So how do we "love the Law" like Jesus did, and not make the mistake of trying to be saved by obeying the law? How do we still trust God and His grace for our salvation and still try to obey the law?
